

## DRAFT GUIDE TO PUBLICATIONS OF ANGLIA I-IV

***[Please note that this document was compiled by McCoog some years ago and has not been completed. October 2015]***

Most historians have experienced more than once the frustration that comes with the discovery that the manuscript one had slavishly transcribed and/or translated, had earlier been published. The frequency of such frustration led to the compilation of references to all relevant published documents; the desire to spare others similar frustration has resulted in its publication. I avoid long descriptions of the documents, since this is not intended as a calendar, and I restrict my references to available published works. Since this article can truly be labelled a “work in progress,” if anyone notices omissions, please submit them to me for future emendations and corrections. I hasten to add that I have not compared the original manuscript with the published text: it is my assumption that the published version is accurate. If anyone has done so with any of the texts under consideration and has noticed serious errors, again please let me know.
